Every year, through its charitable foundation, The GEO Group Foundation, GEO supports charities, schools, community organizations, and higher education scholarships for students across the country.

One of The GEO Group Foundation's main goals is to help deserving students within our local communities achieve their education and career goals through higher education support and youth development.

The GEO Group is committed to making a difference in the communities in which we operate. Every year, through The GEO Group Foundation, we support charities, schools, community organizations, and higher education scholarships for students across the county.

Since 2011, The GEO Group Foundation has donated more than \$27 million to various charitable causes throughout the country, including approximately \$9 million in student scholarships.

As the leading provider of world-class in-custody rehabilitation programs and post-release services, GEO's charitable foundation also focuses on supporting Second Chance Reentry Organizations that help provide resources and support for individuals reentering society.

Additionally, The GEO Group Foundation supports children's organizations that emphasize programming for youth development, diversion programs, and at-risk youth. We believe that supporting such programs helps give local youths the best chance to succeed.

The financial goal this year was once again exceeded for this important cause and a check was presented to St. Jude for \$242,360. The Eastern Region has now raised a total of \$1,591,758 over the past ten years. Each year, The GEO Group Foundation supports the tournament with a \$25,000 donation.

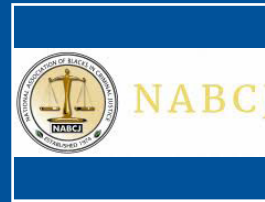

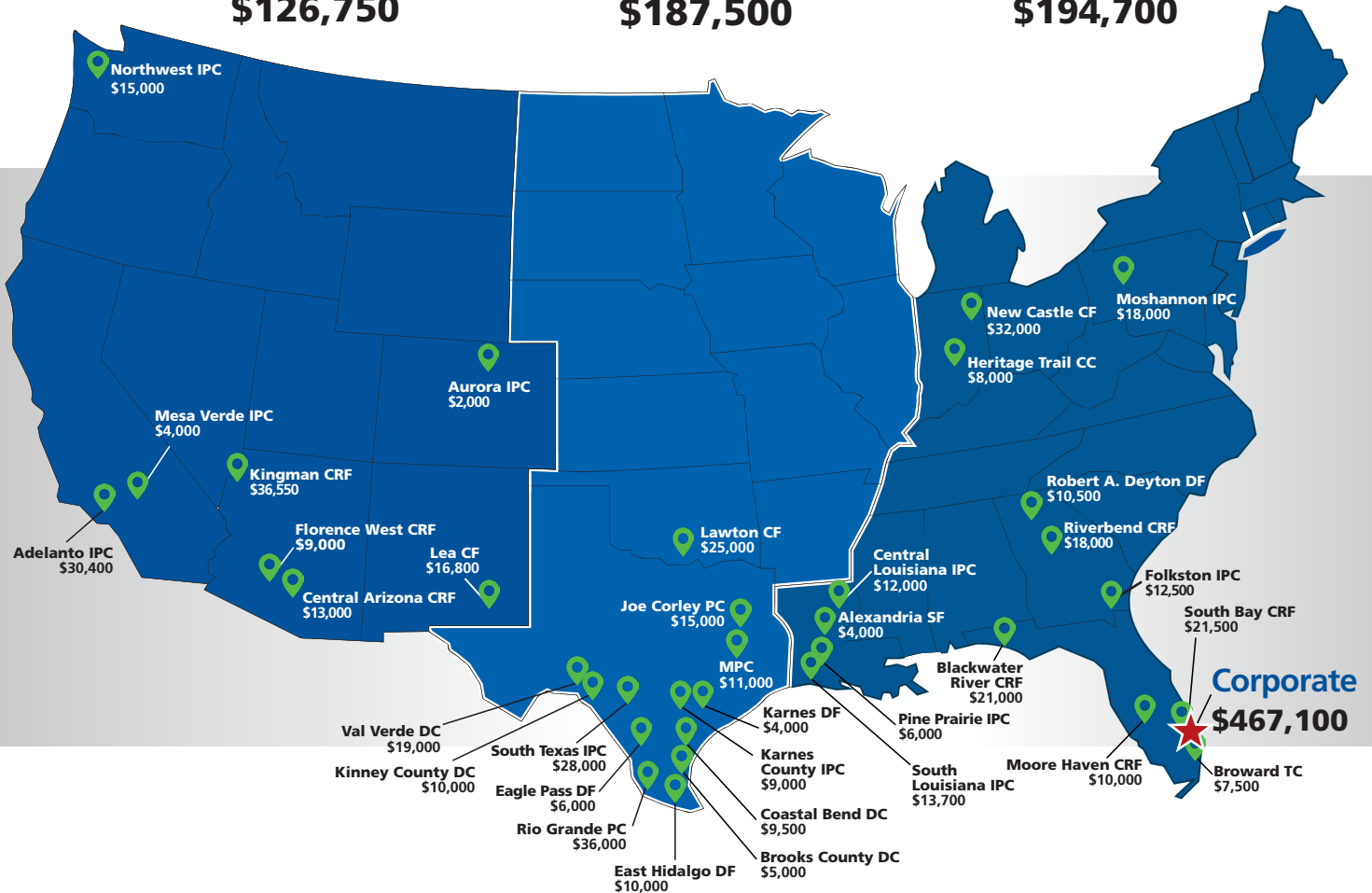

Rio Grande Processing Center Donates \$26,000 to Local Scholarship Program

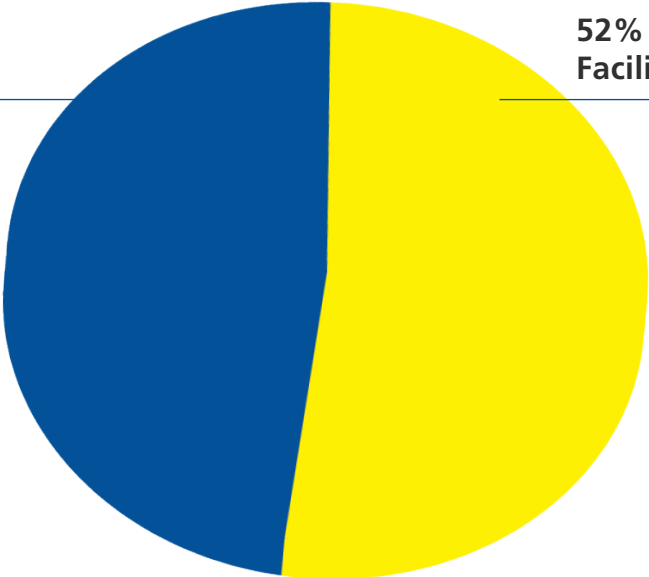

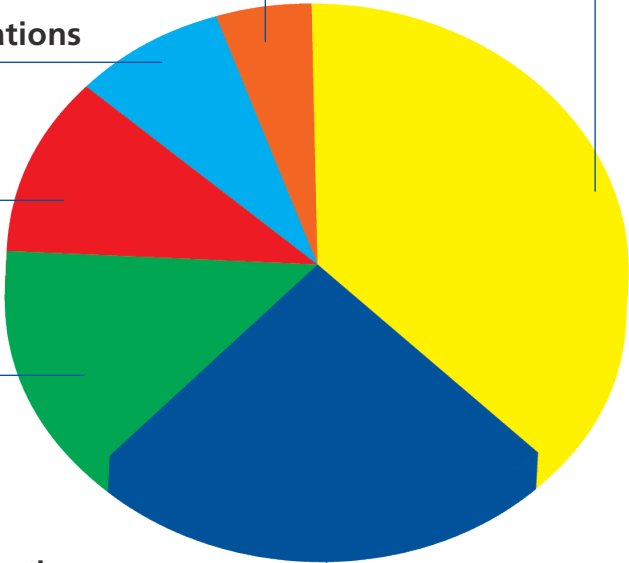

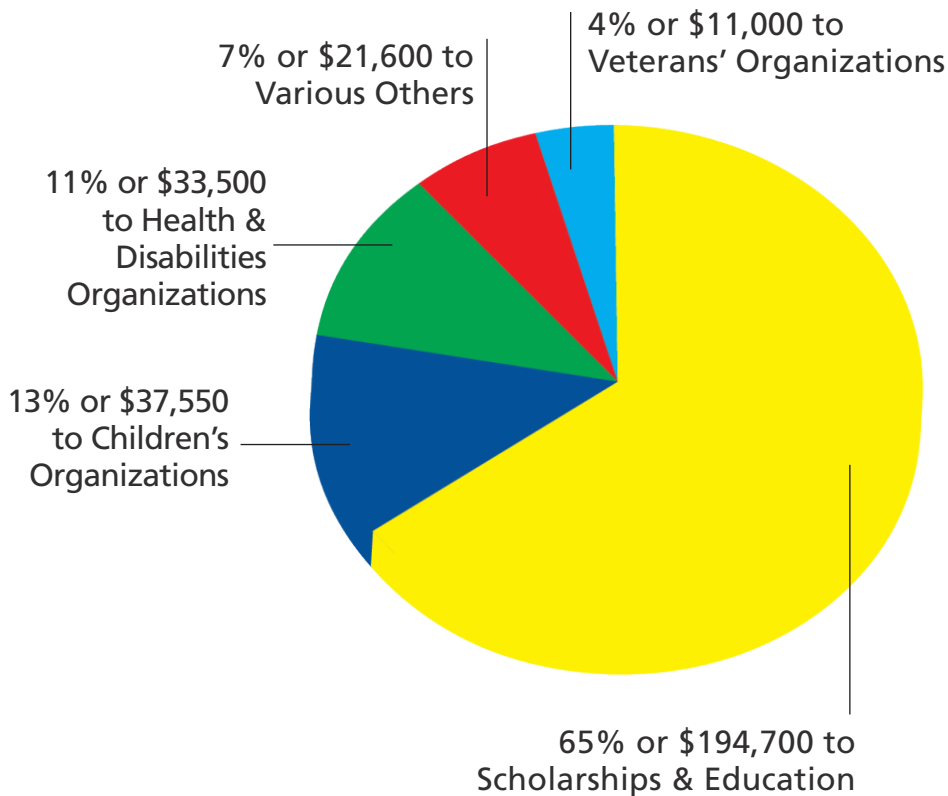

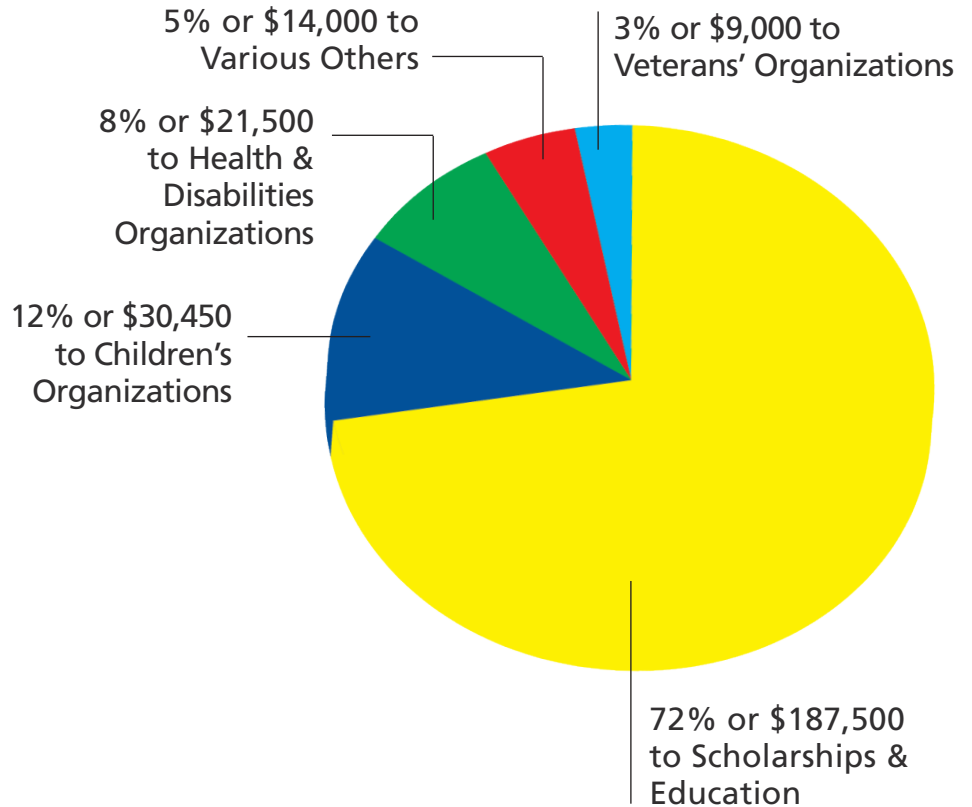

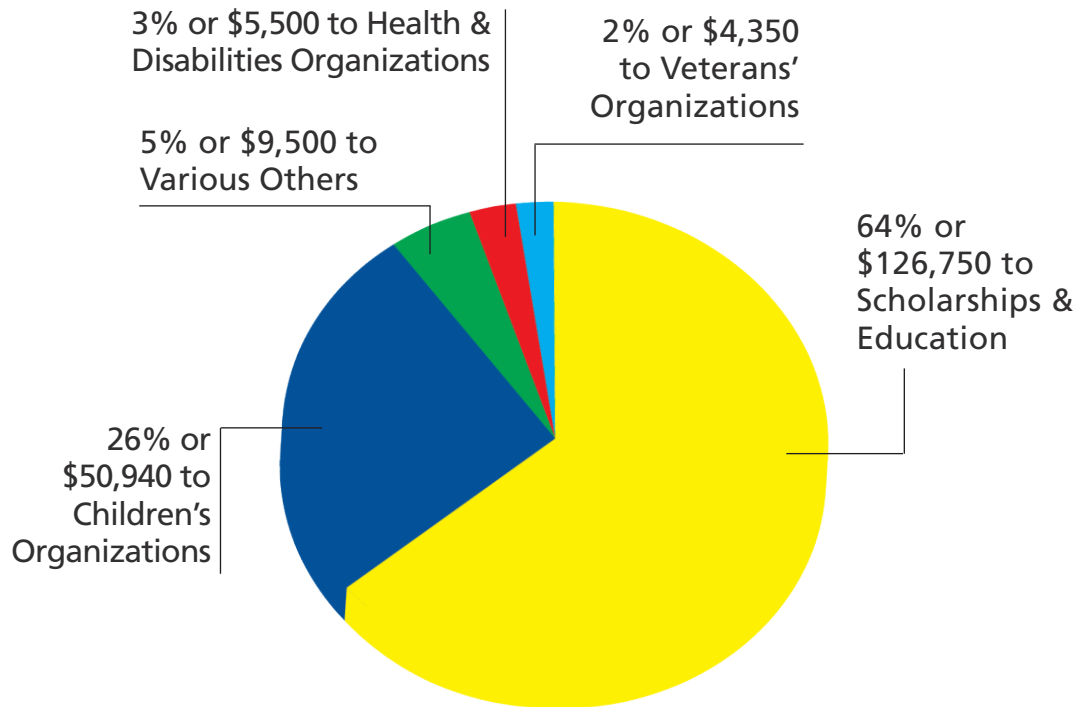

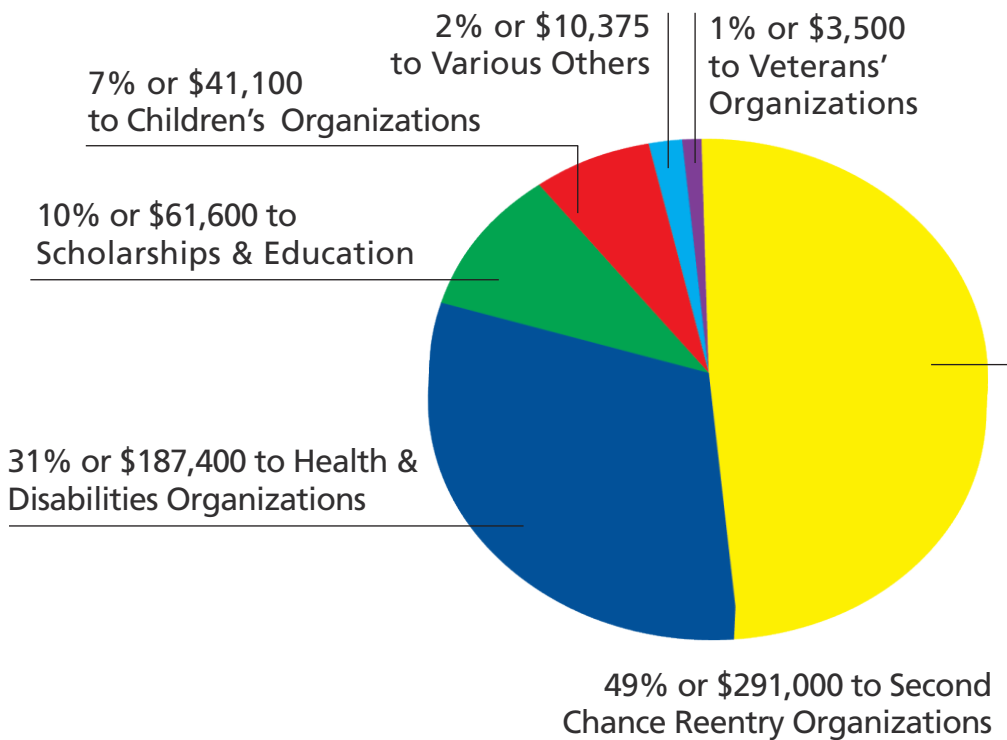
FLORENCE WEST CORRECTIONAL AND REHABILITATION FACILITY DONATES TO PICACHO SCHOOL GARDEN

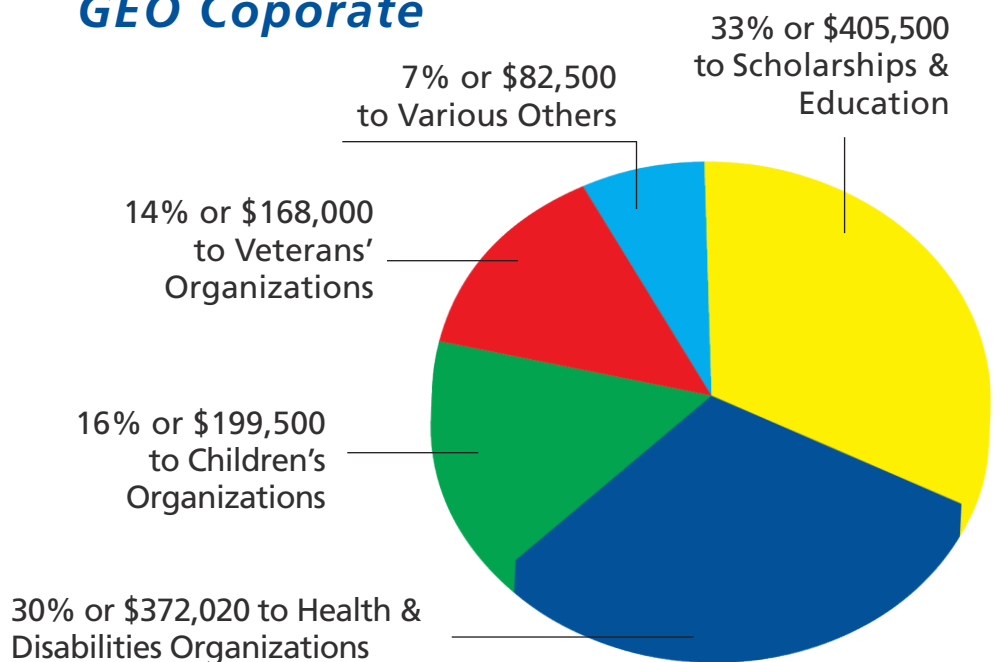
