Since 2011, The GEO Group Foundation has donated more than \$22.2 million to various charitable causes throughout the country, including approximately \$7.5 million in student scholarships.

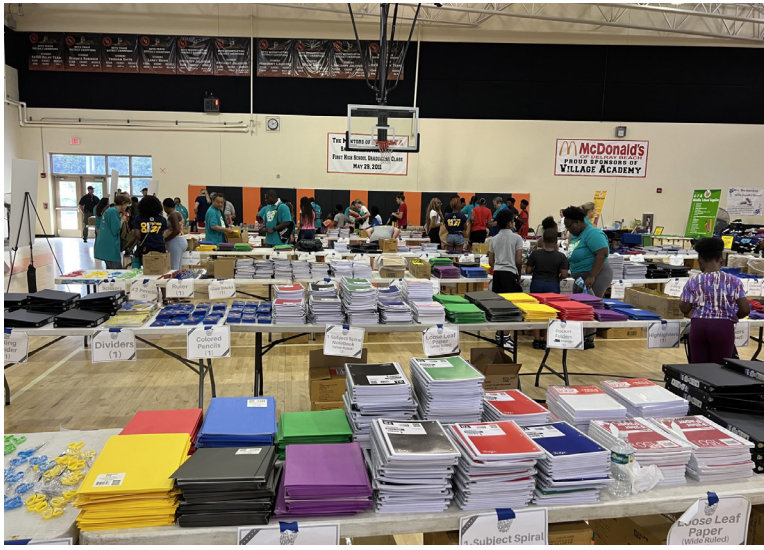

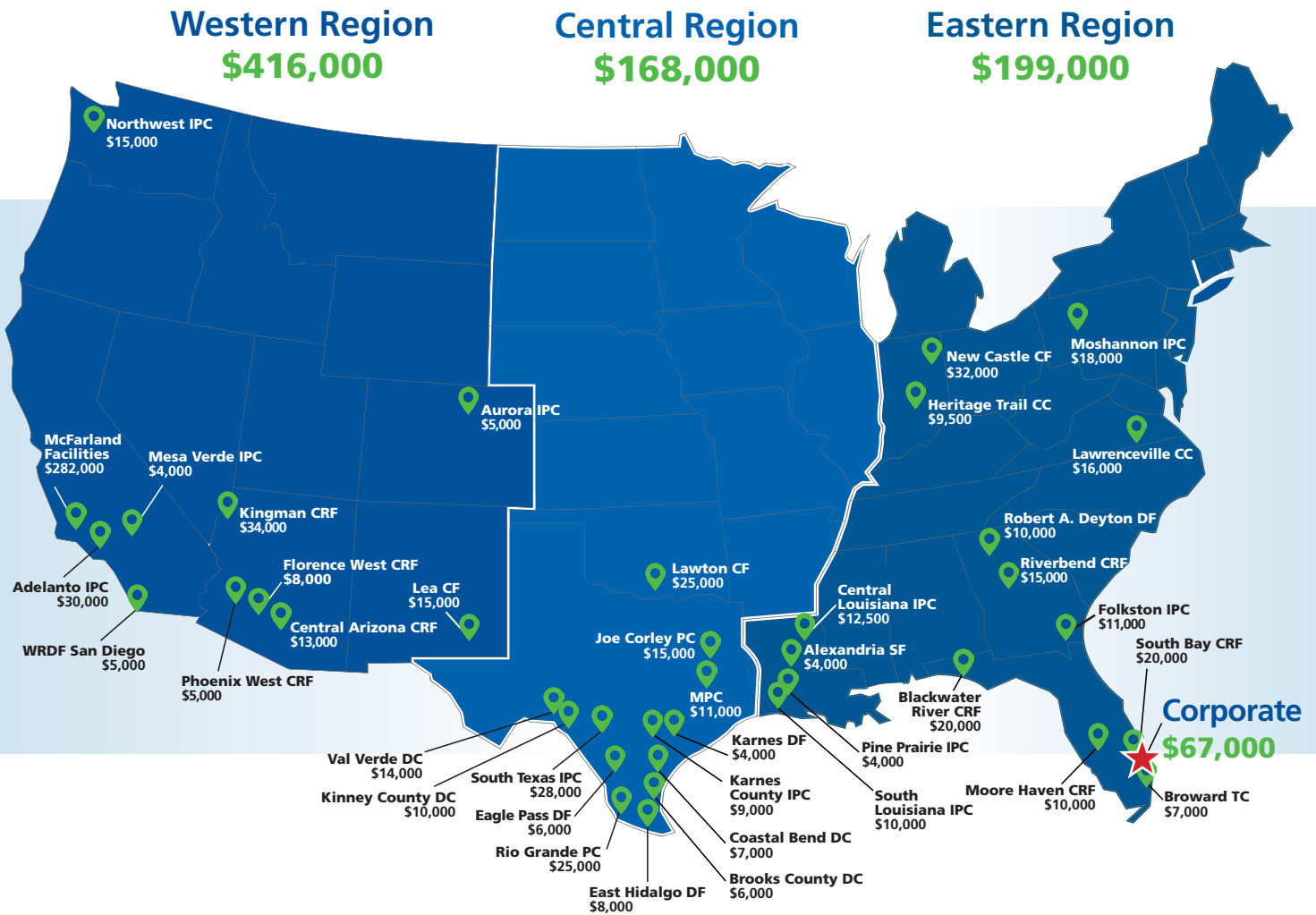

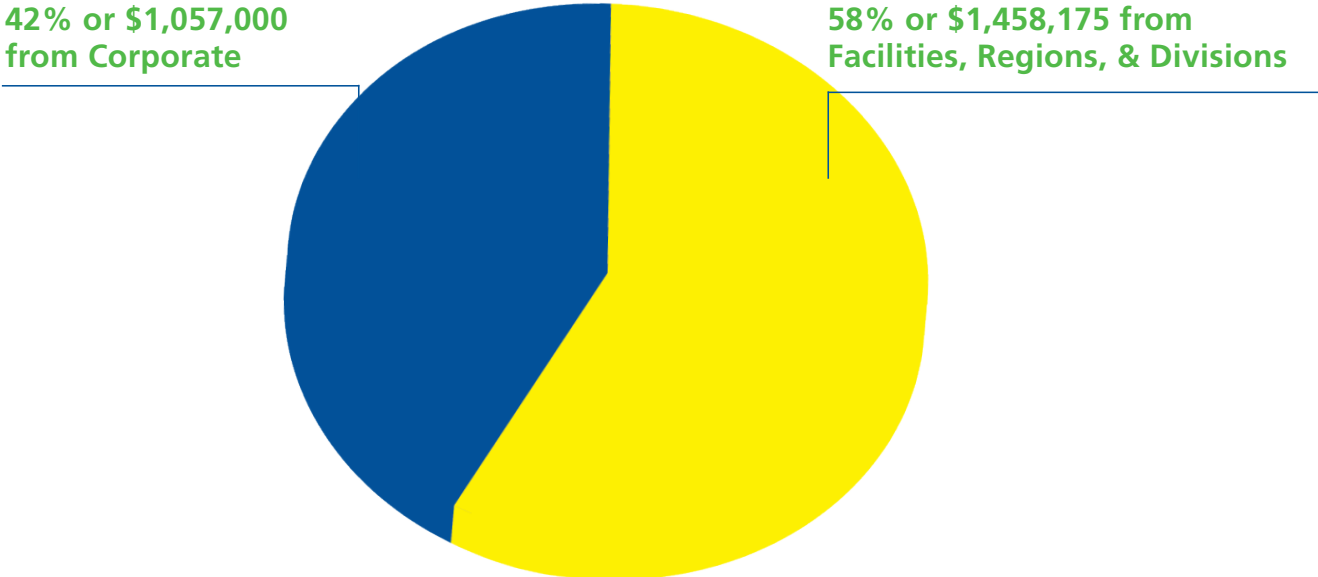


## Folkston ICE Processing Center Awards Scholarships

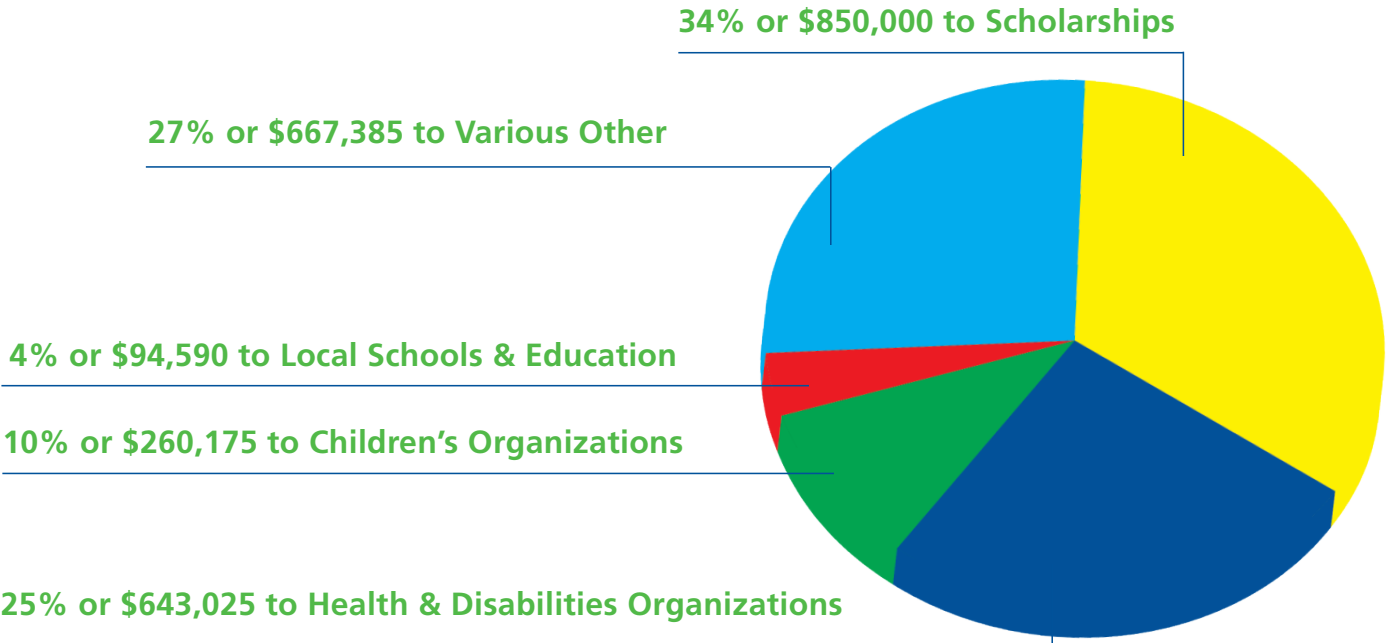

**Donations Breakdown by Recipient Category**



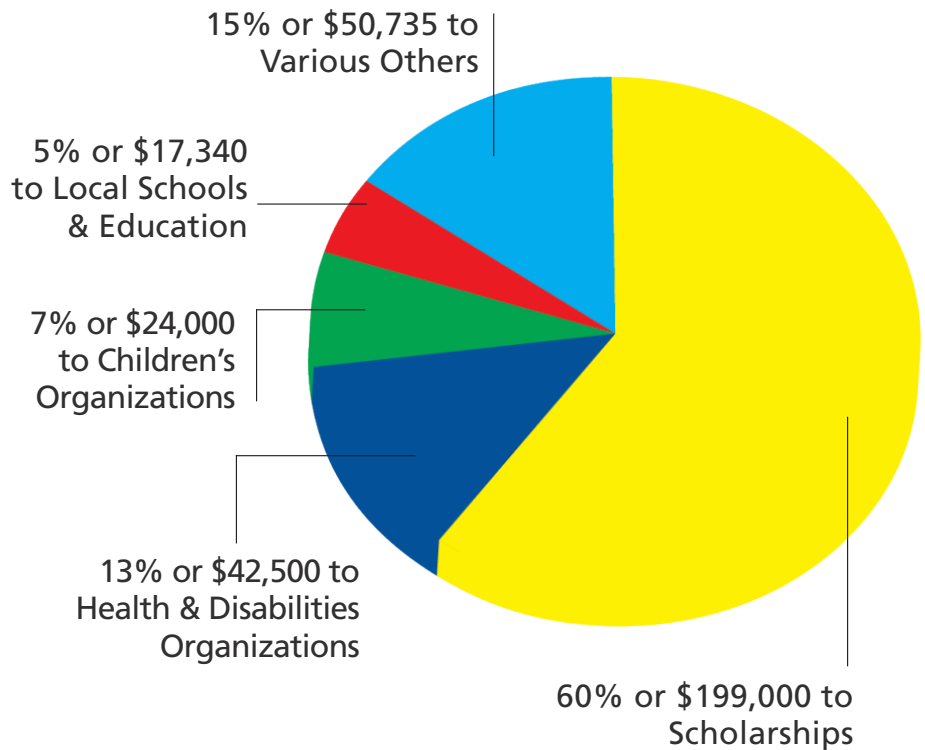

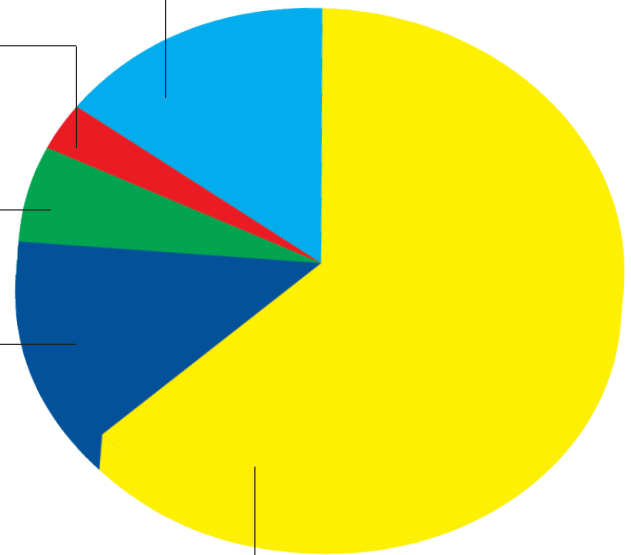

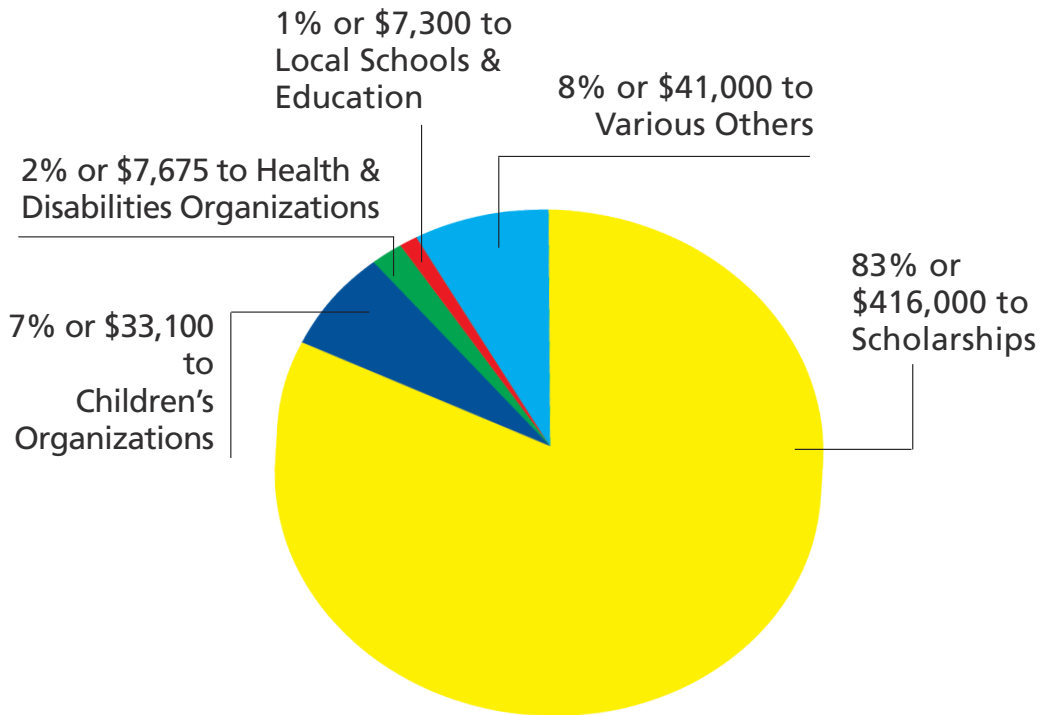

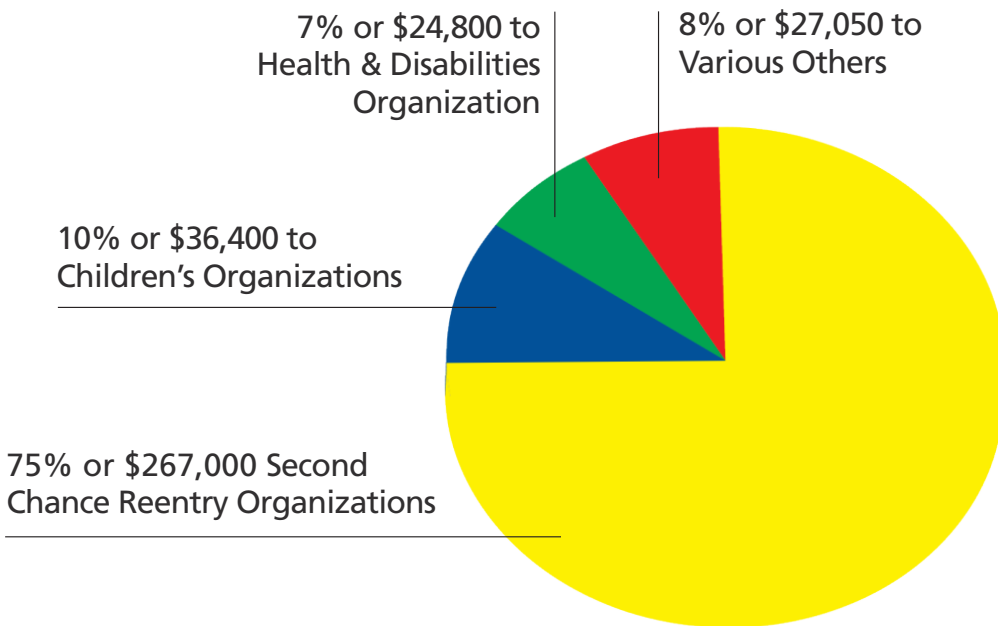
