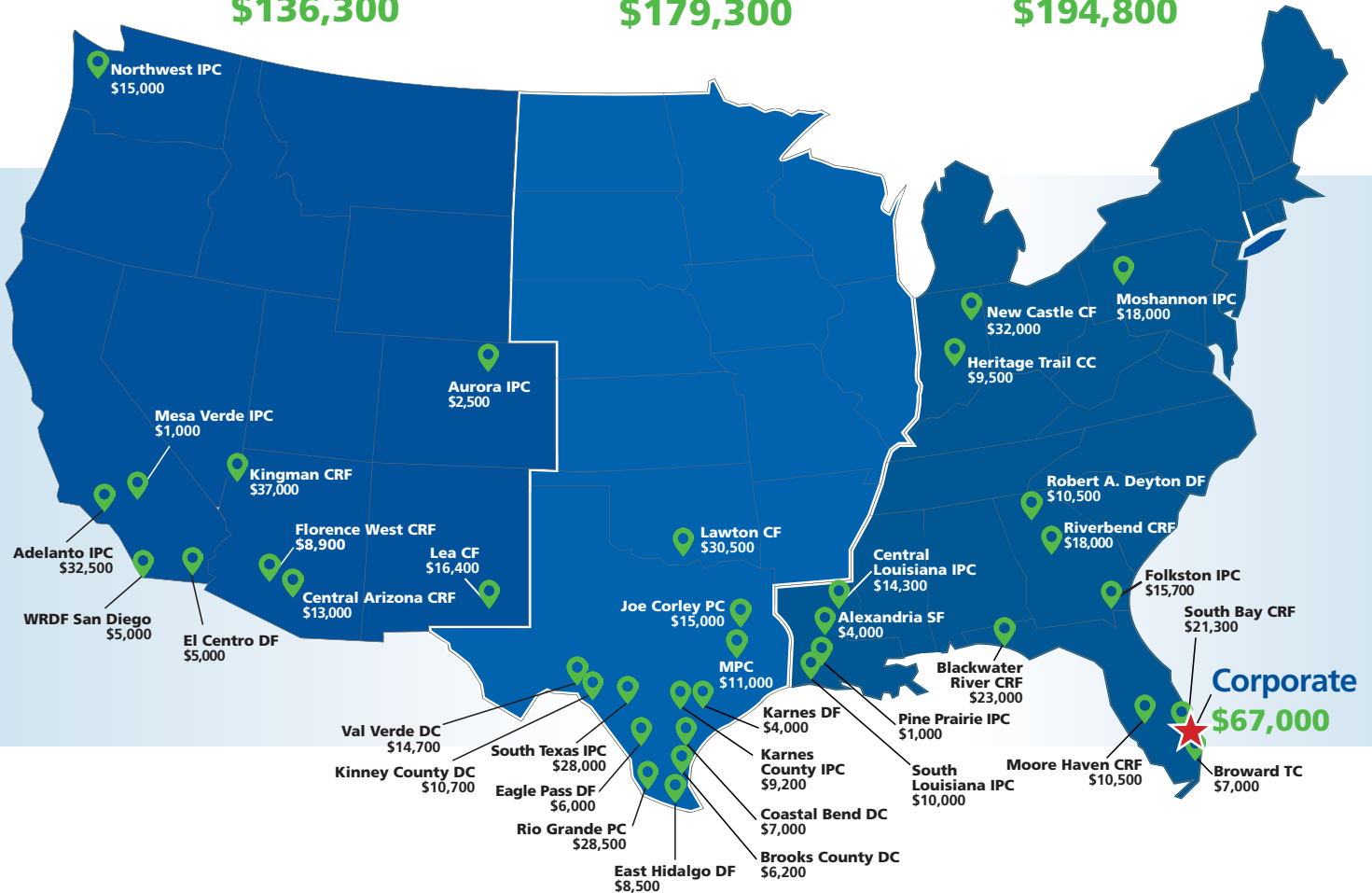

Folkston ICE Processing Center Awards Scholarships



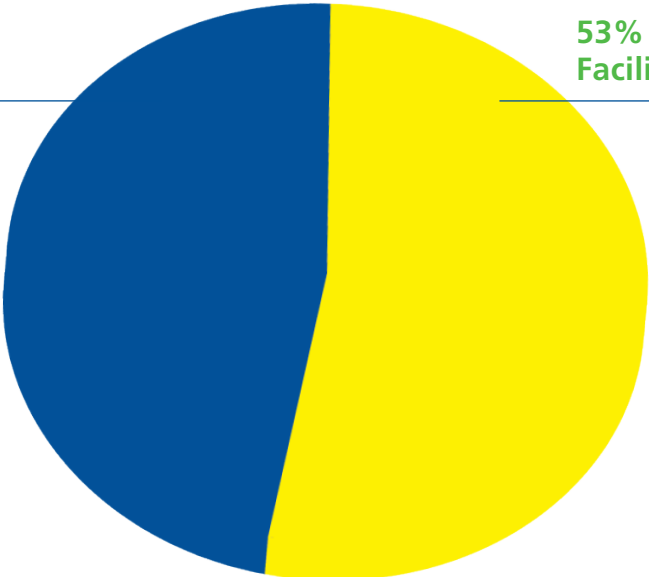

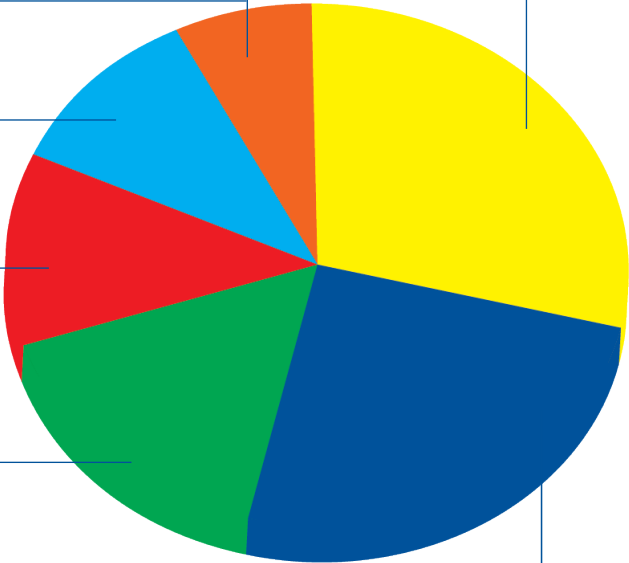

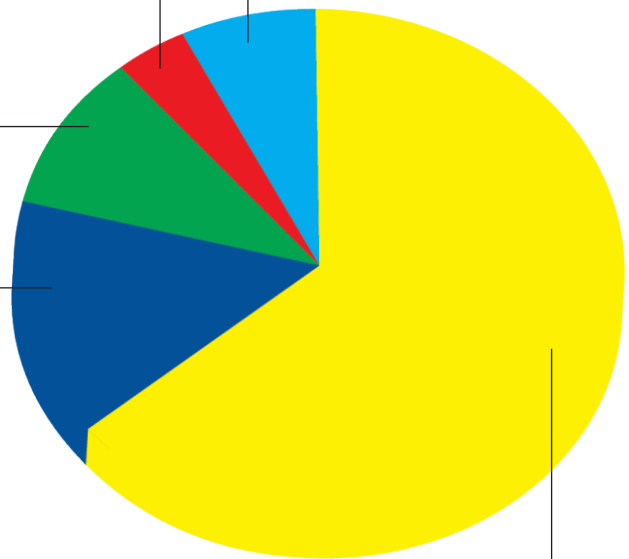

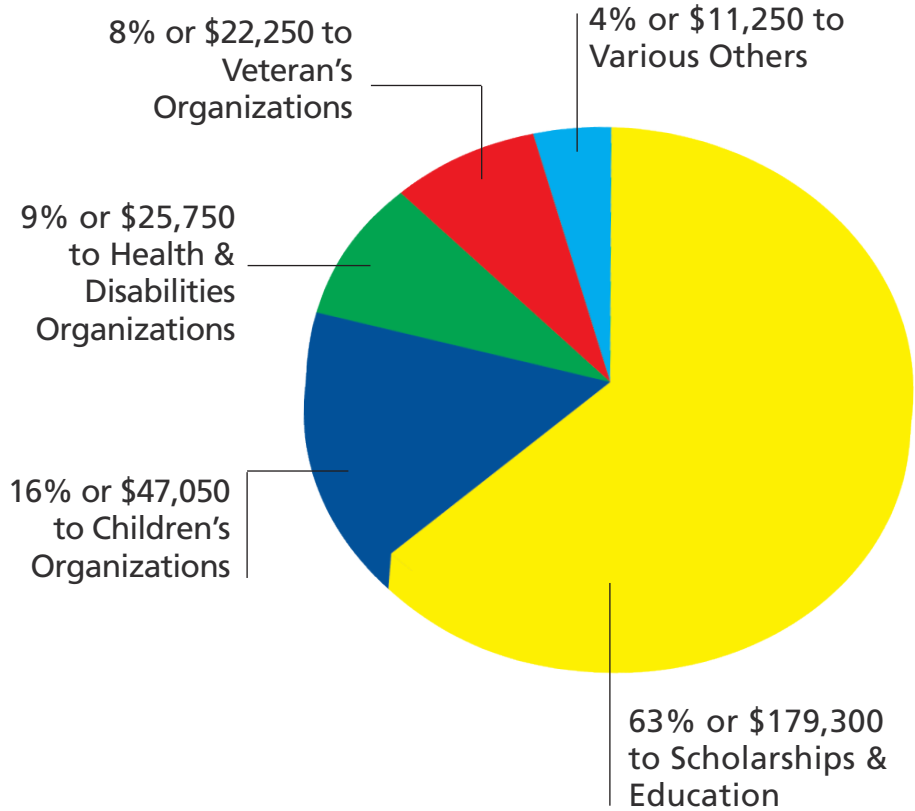

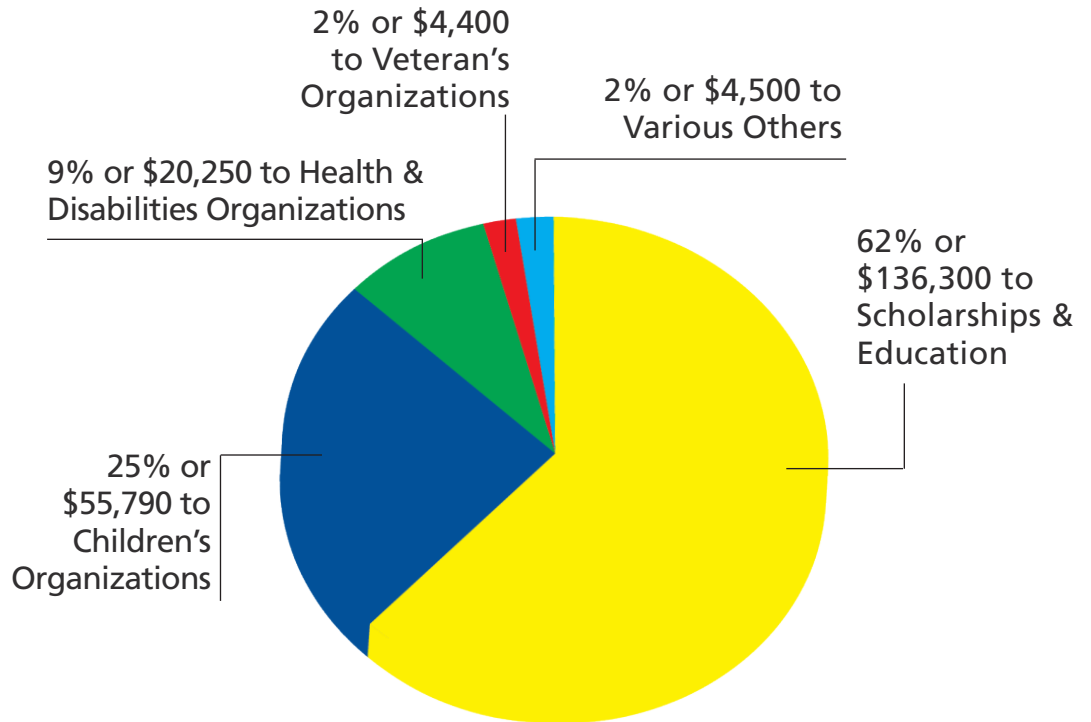

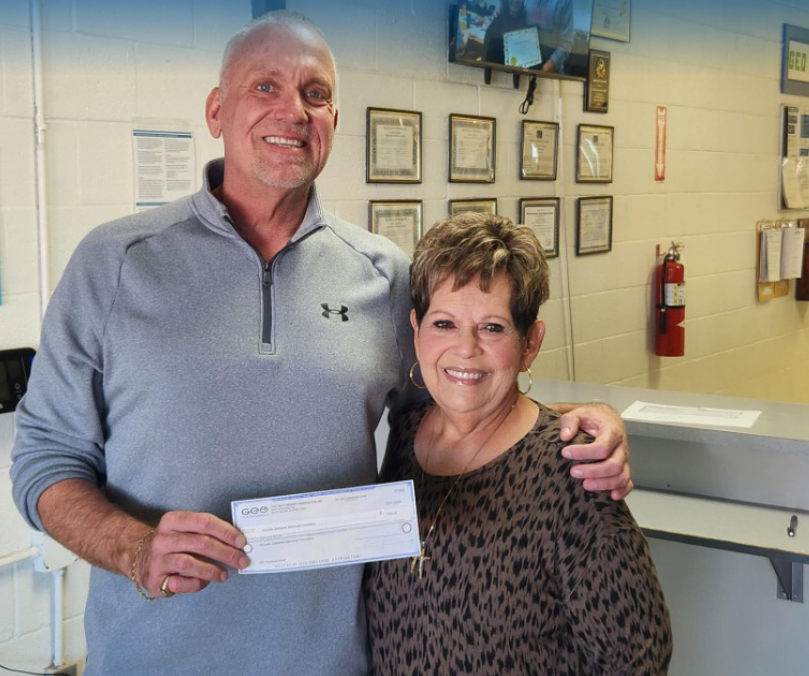

FLORENCE WEST CORRECTIONAL FACILITY HELPING OUR YOUTH

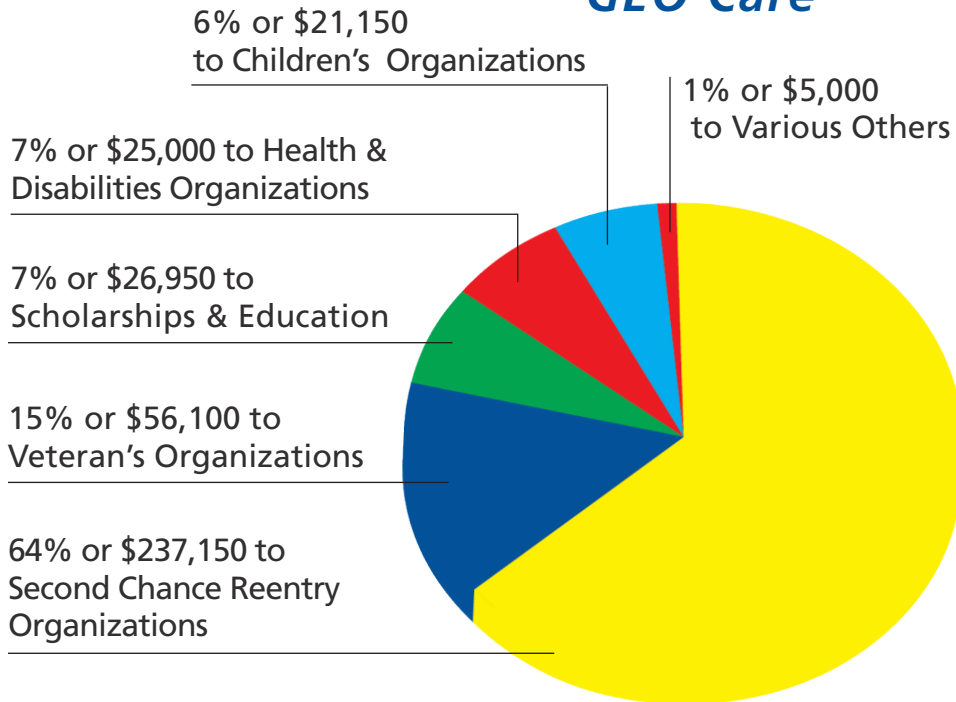

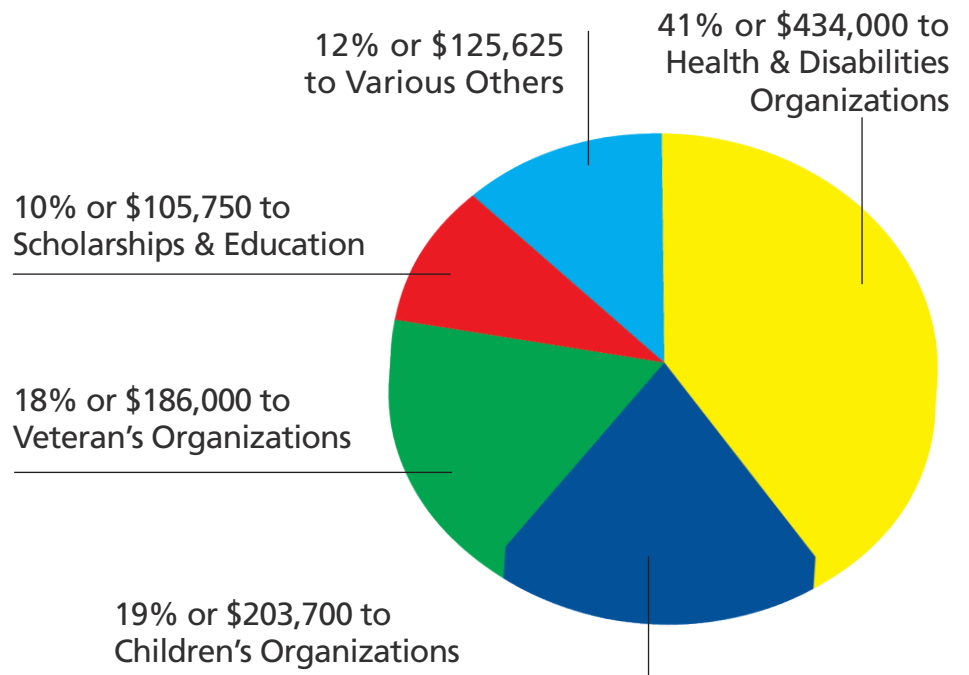
